Contest Briefing for Timers

- 1. Speeches are awarded a 30 second grace. If a speech is 30 seconds over the maximum time or 30 seconds under the minimum time, the speaker will be disqualified.
- 2. Review timing procedures:

a. Table Topics: 2 min (min/max 1:00 - 2:30)

Green 1:00, Amber 1:30, and

Red2:00.

b. Evaluation Contest: 2-3 min (min/max 1:30 - 3:30)

Green 2:00, Amber 2:30, and Red 3:00.

c. Humorous and International:

5-7 min (min/max 4:30 - 7:30)

Green 5:00, Amber 6:00, and

Red7:00.

- 3. One timekeeper to use electronic device, the other uses colored cards simultaneously.
- 4. Timing starts with the first verbal or nonverbal communication with the audience.
- 5. The red light <u>WILL</u> remain on until the speaker has finished speaking. No notice shall be given to indicate a speaker has gone overtime.
- 6. Review and explain to the timing forms to the Timekeepers.
- 7. Contestants and Judges are the only ones allowed to file a protest. All protests must be made to either the Chief Judge and/or Contest Chair.
